



## **DUX PASCAL-SYSTEM**



The Pascal System consists of three or six interchangeable spring cassettes of varying densities and tension.

Designed to provide three support zones – shoulders, hips, legs – each cassette is selected to match your body size and weight for individually customized comfort.

#### **CONFIGURE PASCAL-SYSTEM**




Common configuration is as follows:

SOFT – at the head, allowing your
shoulders to sink into the bed.

MEDIUM – in the middle, allowing hips
to sink down in the bed.

FIRM – at the foot, allowing some
elevation for your legs and feet.


## **ASSEMBLING**



### I. ATTACH THE LEGS


Attach the legs and place the bases close together.






## III. OPEN THE BED

Open the bed and fold the top over.




#### IV. ARRANGE THE CASSETTES

Arrange the cassettes according to your preference.



#### V. FOLD THE TOP BACK OVER

Fold the top back over and zip the bed closed.



# VI. ADJUST THE LUMBAR SUPPORT

To adjust the lumbar support, use the included crank. To increase the firmness, turn the crank clockwise.
